Mr. Munoz informed everyone that the new band director had been hired but it had to be approved by the school board on May 8. After that time, everyone will be informed of who the new band director is. He also informed the boosters that Libby Delaney will be the new color guard instructor. At the present time, the staff has 3 show ideas for the marching season which the new director can use or to form his own.

Out going treasurer Christine Mory reported that Doug Stackhouse is donating the hog for the hog raffle. The boosters will be buying the sausage and pork burgers that are needed for the winners in that raffle.

Christine reported additional costs to the boosters were semi repairs around \$1500, insurance, and color guard music at \$400. We also have to pay for the remainder of supplies that we used for track concessions. The cost is \$700. Patches for the students jackets also have to be purchased. Mr.

Munoz has stressed to the students to turn in forms of any missing patches that they still need. He further stated that other area schools have their students purchase their own patches, This would be one less cost for the boosters if this process was put into place.

SBA Treasurer's Report: Sasha Frazier

Out going SBA treasurer Lisa Hiser reported that the outstanding fees is just under \$10,000. Lisa further stated that \$1400 is on a payment plan, 2 students have paid in full in the last 2 days, and that \$3600 we have filed with the court. The court date that was given was June 4.

Trustee Report: Doug Stackhouse

Doug discussed that a trailer cleaning will be planned in the near future. No date has been set, but anyone that is interested in helping, can contact any member of the board.

Upcoming Events:

The budget is complete. Anyone that would like to have a copy, is welcome Bryan Munoz talked to the members about saving for new uniforms that will be needed in the next couple of years. He also stressed that a budget needed to be kept for trailer repair and eventually, a new trailer. Winter Winds was placed in the budget, so if the new director wanted to continue this winter group, the money would already be in the budget.

Mr Munoz also discussed to keep the budget at a minimum. It was budget for winter groups to only receive a new tarp and new uniforms every other year. The budget for staff was also tightened. Because of these changes, the marching band fee for students was not raised. The only exception to this, is that the percussion will pay an extra \$25. This is for the purchase of their personal mallots. The color guard will pay an extra \$75. This additional cost will be for their jazz shoes, body tights, and make up.

Sara Stein is going to promote Scrip, Kroger, and Amazon Smiles at the call out meeting. All questions concerning Scrip can be answered by Sara.

John Mory discussed that co-chairs and volunteers are needed for all events. This will be discussed at the call out meetings on May 8 and May 9.

New Business:

Laundry detergent sales will start soon. Delivery will be on June 20 and pick up will be on June 22.

Dave Derry discussed the bowling fundraiser that he is chairing and the amount of profit that could be obtained.

Qualifying fundraisers that the students can earn towards their SBA accounts was also discussed. The beef raffle sales will be spit 85/15 but all further qualifying fundraisers profit will be split 75/25. Qualifying fundraiser include: laundry detergent, rise n roll, and hog raffle. Band cards will be split 50/50 like previous years.
