Reminders for all performances:

1. ALL band members will wear show shirts on contest days. All members except guard will wear show shirts under their full uniform. All non-guard members must have TALL black socks. No jewelry or cell phones while in uniform. Absolutely no food or drinks while in uniform. Water is the only exception. Students will stay in FULL uniform once they are on. The full uniform stays on at all performances (football, parade, contest) and jackets will not come off until the entire band is given permission to change.
2. Students are responsible for making sure their equipment is in working order, have everything to be successful including instruments, reeds, valve oil, sticks, flags, rifles, and any other materials and supplies that are necessary for an incredible performance. **BE PREPARED!**
3. The band boosters will feed band members at each contest or before leaving for contests. You can also pack snacks and bring cash for concessions. Plan accordingly based on the itinerary for the week.
4. School rules will be in effect at all times.
5. Please leave the bus cleaner than you find it.
6. Chaperones are on each bus. See your chaperone or director with any issues or concerns.
7. Students are to ride the bus to and from each contest. If there is an extenuating circumstance, students may ride with a parent but must have a signed note and a face-to-face conversation with a bus chaperone, Mr. Witzigreuter, or Mr. Spellman.
8. Treat other school facilities with respect, and always behave appropriately.
9. Absolutely **NO** playing instruments or spinning flags/rifles at any contest until given permission by a band/guard director at the designated warm-up location. The band will receive a penalty from a contest official if this rule is not followed.
10. Treat other school band members with respect, supporting and cheering for them.
11. Band members are not to sit on the home side of the stadium during contests, this area is for patrons. There is a student section on the opposing side of the stadium. Only appropriate comments and cheering for other bands is acceptable. Please support each other, you ALL work hard.
