We would purchase the remaining items from the concessions program (\$746) and more as needed. We must purchase Coke products from the vendor directly. March 12th is first meet. This money will go to the general fund. Sign ups on CHARMS. There will be a drawing after each event for a **chance to win SBA credit**. Nicol Trout is the contact person. Temp must be at least 40 degrees or they cancel. There will be an equal chance to participate, not the same people signing up for every event (unless no one is signing up).

6. Background check renewals: Many expire at the end of this school year (see Kris DeLong to verify). They will need to be updated, especially if you are going on the Disney trip in the fall. These cover all the schools, not just band. Paperwork is available at the meeting or on the bulletin board. These are to be returned to Cathy Wright at the corporation office or Kris DeLong (with a copy of your driver's license).
7. Semi-trailer repairs: \$1500. Can begin as soon as the WP season is over. Extra repairs will take place. Concern and comments about the paint and possible insurance claim to repair it. Exhaust has caused some damage, but paint is chipping off. This will be looked in to.
8. Discussion regarding trailer with fryers is up and running, ready to use at events. If Avilla does not give us a spot to sell concessions, we may look at marching in the Mermaid parade. We need to contact Avilla ASAP to get signed up.
9. Discussion regarding the need to move band fees to the school and allow the school to start taking SBA arrears to court. Payments will be made from the boosters to the school. Further discussion to be help. This could result in more fundraisers being 100% SBA, and only using major fundraisers as general funds. Concern that major fundraisers, such as July 4th, Fall invitational, and the Fly in were all seriously effected by the weather, so banking on those to keep the general funds in the black could be risky.
10. Discussion regarding engaging participation in fundraisers. These bring good money, but a lot of times parents sign up and then don't show up.
